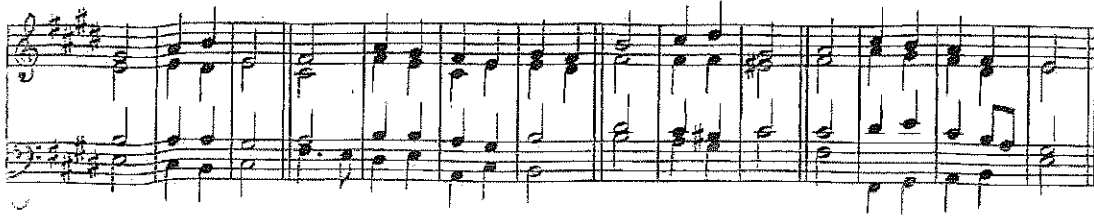


PSALM 84. *Quam dilecta!*
