The Grace Church Choir Program seeks to sustain and strengthen the rich tradition of choral offerings at Grace Church by fostering a community for everyone celebrating excellence in music and God's love for all. The Choir Program welcomes singers and musicians who desire to celebrate and extend this ministry undertaken by Grace Church.

A Note from P. Allen: I want to thank every one of you for being part of the Choir Family. We are stewards of an amazing choral foundation! Our program is based on an ancient tradition, most recently in the past thousand years in England secured in the Cathedrals and Collegiate Chapels.

Our program is grounded in the Book of Common Prayer that affirms our respect of the dignity of all humanity. The choristers follow the ancient model of being the sopranos for professional choirs where adults sing the alto, tenor and bass parts. The experience a child receives in this type of training is unique and equips them in so many special ways for the rest of their life. With such a history, choirs over the past thousand years have experienced many challenges. This pandemic is ours at the moment. The structure of our daily choir life will support us all as we meet the challenges of the pandemic and the need for flexibility and change to keep everyone safe.

Part of what makes the program so special is the mentoring of the younger choristers by the older ones. That is why, throughout the program design, you will witness opportunities for the three training levels to overlap. That being written, please consider sending your novice or junior chorister in on a regular Sunday with the respective boys or girls senior choir several times a school term. That way, they can stand with the seniors and be immersed in the sound and practice of the older choristers.

I am also asking our Senior Families to send in their choristers to the novice and junior rehearsals several times each term, an/or to mentor a junior Evensong, a "junior" Sunday, or the Treble Concert. That "book buddy" musical relationship is essential for the musical and communal growth of our foundation. This is how we connect across the grades and years. It would be better if we can achieve this in spirit without rules than have to move towards more structure or required days.

Let's have fun, make great memories, and create beautiful music in this special anniversary season! It is once in all our lives to be part of this time! Let the music and fun flow! PA

(With parents permission, Seniors are welcome to participate as Senior Mentors and work on leadership skills as they inspire and support the younger choristers.)

 - 4. May 15: Juniors and Novices with 4th and 5th grade Seniors
- Required Choral Evensong Services (Seniors sing; Juniors and Novices process and attend): GIRLS: December 12 Britten Ceremony of Carols 4:00 pm (Senior Girls).

A Festival of Nine Lessons and Carols December 24 8:00pm,

Easter Day April 17, 9:00 and 11:00 am services.

Concerts (ALL choristers should attend BOTH concerts. Seniors should support and listen to Juniors/Novices and Juniors/Novices should support and listen to Seniors – it's FUN.)

- *Juniors and Novices:* February 6th: Annual Concert of Music for Treble Voices featuring Novice and Junior Choristers, Promotion of 3rd grade Novices.
- Seniors: April 29: The Annual Spring Choir Concert and Reception

After School Choir Coaching and Voice Lessons

- Vocal Coaching: 4 sessions fall semester and 6 spring semester and mandatory for Seniors and Optional for Juniors.
- Sessions Offered: Sopranos: Tuesdays 3:30-4:30 and Fridays after dismissal for an hour. Shaving Club: tbd. Advance sign-up required.
- Senior Mentoring counts towards vocal coaching credit. Every Senior should mentor at least 10 times over the whole season. These count as vocal coaching also.
- Sign Up: Use the Vocal Coaching Sign Up Genius Link that will go active in September.

- Absences or Lateness. Penalties apply unless excused
- Leave of Absence. Consult Handbook
- Dates of Required Attendance for All Choristers. Consult Handbook (on website) for full schedule. Consult Choir website weekly for updates and changes.

Church Conduct

- Dress Code for Services and Offerings. Appropriate Sunday clothes with dark shoes
 - *Boys*. Dark dress shoes (no sneakers) with dark socks, white collared shirt and tie, black or navy pants (no khaki)
 - *Girls.* Black or navy dress shoes (no sneakers, open-toed shoes, sandals, clogs or flip flops), white, black or navy socks or tights or nude-colored hose, dress or skirt that is appropriate for church, no collar showing above the cassock except a simple white collar, no noticeable hair ornaments
 - *Choir Clothes Closet.* Appropriate clothes available for borrowing
- Rehearsal Drill and Service Drill. Enter at 802 Broadway at 7 am (not before) on weekdays and 9:45 am on Sundays
- *Communion.* Receiving only a blessing is perfectly appropriate
- Dismissal. After the Daily Prayer for Choristers

Social Conduct

- Expectations and Standards of Behavior. Respect, attentiveness, teamwork, commitment and accountability
- *Misconduct*. May result in suspension, fines or termination
- Wrongful Treatment. Should be reported immediately
- Feedback. Provide to the Choirmaster
