Most up to date Covid Protocol Information (based on the most recent communication issued by GCS)

Return from Positive Test Quarantine

Fully vaccinated people who test positive for Covid-19 must quarantine and isolate. They may return to in-person after **five days** from the date of their positive test (day zero) if they are symptom free, have had no fever for 24 hours and are feeling well.

Counting days begins from the date of the positive test, which is day zero. On the sixth day, students may return if they are symptom free, have had no fever for 24 hours and are feeling well.

Return from Household Quarantine

If a fully vaccinated person lives with someone who tests positive for Covid-19, they can return after five days if they are symptom free AND present a negative test taken after the fifth day.

Exposure

Fully vaccinated choristers who are vaccinated and boosted who are exposed to Covid-19 by a contact from outside of their household do not have to quarantine. They must monitor their symptoms closely and get tested on the fifth day from exposure.

Unvaccinated and partially vaccinated people who are exposed as a close contact (indoors, unmasked for 15 or more minutes in a 24-hour period), must quarantine for 5 days.

Masking

Masks will continue to be required at all times. All members of the community should wear properly fitting KN95, N95, or surgical masks moving forward. The data suggest that these

masks provide much more protection than cloth masks especially against the more contagious Omicron variant. These masks are readily available at drug stores and from online retailers.

FESTIVAL OF MUSIC FOR TREBLE VOICES 1-6 FEBRUARY, 2022

The Senior Girls were originally scheduled to sing on Sunday morning 6 February. That is cancelled, the Adults will sing in the morning. All Girls and HS Singers should sing and support the Festival Concert that afternoon.

There will be no morning rehearsals the week of February 1 - 4 we will put all our energy and focus into the afternoon sessions.

All Choristers are expected to participate.

^{*}All things Covid....

^{*} Everyone over the age of 12 must be vaccinated a minimum of two weeks prior to first rehearsal.

*Anyone ineligible for the vaccine or under 12 must have had a negative covid test not more than 72 hours prior to first rehearsal. If your child is a Grace Church School student, their school test submission is sufficient. If your child attends another school, please <u>submit</u> negative test results <u>here</u>.
