

Behavioral Covenant for Choristers

As a representative of Grace Church in New York and as an ambassador for the United States, I understand that I have a responsibility to behave in an honest, courteous, and respectful manner at all times. I will treat my fellow travelers with kindness, and, in the spirit of cooperation, I will follow the tour's rules and guidelines for the benefit of the group at large.

Any one of the following may be cause for asking a chorister and/or member/s of a chorister's family, to leave the tour, at the sole expense of the family:

1. Disrespectful behavior of any kind, either to an adult or to another chorister;
2. Unnecessarily loud or rude public behavior, particularly on planes, in restaurants, museums, and the churches we will be visiting;
3. Not following the proper dress code;
4. Inappropriate use of technology including the use of devices when unauthorized. Use of devices by choristers is not permitted during group meals;
5. Being late continually for rehearsals, services, meals, outings, and check-in;
6. Causing disturbance in the hotels which will prevent others from getting rest and sleep;
7. Under-aged children using alcohol, cigarettes, or drugs of any kind other than prescription drugs or approved over-the-counter medication.

I agree to refrain from any of the above, and I understand that if I do any of those things, Dr. Allen may ask me, and my entire family, to leave the tour. If I am a chorister traveling without a family member, I understand that Dr. Allen can call my parents and they will buy me a ticket home on the next flight available.
